Parking

- ➤ The indoor parking lot downstairs (Parking Lot 2) will be closed at 1:00 pm on Sundays. Afterwards, you will have to wait until 10:00 am on Tuesday morning to collect your vehicle.

- ► To be considerate of our neighbors, please do not park in the residential area.
- ▶ Please do not double park.
- ▶ When parking in the outdoor parking lot downstairs (Parking Lot 2), please be careful not to block the emergency exits and keep a distance of 3 feet from the building's exterior wall so that the emergency exit doors can be fully opened.
- ► Please park and lock your bike/e-bike outside. Do not park the bike inside the building.

Scripture Reading Plan

- ▶ January 6 marks the day of Epiphany, ushering in a new season on the Christian Calendar. The word "Epiphany" means "appearance" or "manifestation." During this season, we focus on reflecting on the ministry of Jesus, starting with His baptism.
- ► From now until the beginning of Lent, we will journey through the narratives of Jesus in Matthew, Mark, and Luke, covering the period from His baptism to just before His final entrance into Jerusalem. As you read these Gospel stories, pay close attention to how the glory of God is revealed in the life of Jesus. Let these accounts deepen your understanding and appreciation of His mission and ministry.

- 10. How can we self-reflect and respond appropriately when confronted with criticism or being "written off" by others?

- 17. Commit yourself to pursuing a life of the Jesus Way, entrusting yourself to God through prayer. Ask the Holy Spirit to shape you to be more like Jesus.
