Parking

- ▶ When parking in the outdoor parking lot downstairs (Parking Lot 2), please be careful not to block the emergency exits and keep a distance of 3 feet from the building's exterior wall so that the emergency exit doors can be fully opened.
- ► Please park and lock your bike/e-bike outside. Do not park the bike inside the building.

- 6. How does Jesus' baptism act as a "prophetic action" and a preview of His ministry?
- 7. What connections can be drawn between Jesus' baptism and the Christian call to mission?

- 8. What emotions arise when you think of Jesus identifying with humanity through His baptism?
- 9. Have you ever experienced God's love, affirmation, or empowerment in your own life? What was that like?
- 10. How does the idea of living out your baptismal life challenge or inspire you emotionally?
- 11. How do you feel about the idea of mission being an act of love rather than duty?
- 12. What fears or hesitations do you have about engaging in the mission Jesus calls us to?

13. What are the hindrances (including internal and external) for you to live the baptismal life? What are the effective ways to remove these hindrances? Please ask your group members for advice.

- 14. Resolve to live the baptismal life. Share how practically you'll do this with your group members.
- 15. Invite a group member to be your accountability partner, and give him/her permission to rebuke you when you have not followed through on your resolution.
- 16. Commit to live the baptismal life. Ask the Holy Spirit to mould you more into the likeness of Jesus.
